Option Three: Place Corridors

This option builds upon the existing nature of Springwood as a large, dispersed centre with activity nodes within it. This option is the most reflective of the current planning scheme arrangements where significant development is available within the centre along key road corridors and within the existing Springwood centres. Over 20 years, Springwood will have four “places” or centres with their own look and feel, identity and size.

- The Underwood centre
- The Compton Rd centre
- The core area (major commercial east and major commercial retail)
- Slacks Creek south (Ikea and Motorline)

Under this option, there will be:

- A new town centre fronting Vanessa Boulevard
- New community facilities within each node at Underwood, Springwood and Slacks Creek East
- Supports the future extension of the South East Busway to Paradise Road
- Allows for future development of the centre by accentuating the connecting road network on Compton Road, Logan Road, Springwood Road, Rochedale Road, Cinderella Drive and Barbarella Drive
