The owner shall be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the trade waste diversion valve. Accordingly, the owner shall enter into a maintenance contract with the supplier of the equipment, or other approved organisation, to ensure the proper operation of the unit. Inspections and maintenance by the maintenance contractor shall be carried out at least once every 26 weeks for a standard diversion valve and once every 12 weeks for valves with first flush or hydrocarbon sensors. The contractor's service report shall be forwarded to Council within 30 days of the due date of service.
