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EXCLUSIONS

The fixed price does NOT include excavation of rock. Rock is defined as material geologically in place which requires the use of explosives or pneumatic drills or breakers for its removal. Rock includes any boulders of equal hardness which exceed 0.4m³ in volume.

The fixed price does NOT include latent conditions. Latent conditions are defined as physical conditions on the site or its surroundings, including artificial things, but excluding weather conditions, which differ materially from the physical conditions which should reasonably have been anticipated by Logan Water at the time of preparation of the fixed price had Logan Water:

- examined all information relevant to the risk, contingencies and other circumstances having an effect on the works and obtainable by the making of reasonable enquiries;
- inspected the site and its surroundings;
- examined all information made available in writing by the applicant.

If during the execution of the work Logan Water becomes aware of a latent condition, Logan Water shall notify the applicant in writing, specifying

- the latent condition and in what respect it differs materially;
- the additional work, additional resources and additional time required to deal with the latent condition;
- the estimate of the cost of the measures necessary to deal with the latent condition.

Excavation of rock (if encountered) and additional costs associated with latent conditions will be charged for on an hourly rate basis.
