

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

Chambers Flat Road Upgrade

April 2023

SEE Civil is the appointed contractor to construct the Chambers Flat Road upgrade between Mount Lindesay Highway to just north of Kings Way.

Progress update

Work to construct foundations of the new Chambers Flat Road Norris Creek Bridge is underway.

In March, Chambers Flat Road was realigned to allow safe construction within the Norris Creek Bridge footprint.

Over 80,000m³ of suitable earth fill is required to build the new foundations. Approximately 50,000m³ has been placed to date.

The project will now move into Stage 2 of construction and extend work activities into Zones 1, 2 and 4 (*please refer to project zone map for locations*).

Zone 4 works

From late April 2023, works to build the Chambers Flat Road upgrade will extend into Zone 4 of the project corridor and include road reserve works under controlled traffic conditions.

Upcoming traffic changes

From Wednesday 26 April 2023, an extension to the east-bound lane closure of Chambers Flat Road will extend to include Zone 4 of the project. The east-bound lane closure will be in place for the remaining life of the project (expected in 2024 – subject to weather and construction conditions).

Motorists will be able to travel in a west-bound direction only (towards the Mount Lindesay Highway). For your safety and the safety of workers, please follow the direction of traffic control and signage.

Road reserve works

From late April 2023, SEE Civil will be undertaking early works within the road reserve in front of properties within Zone 3 & 4.

Road reserve works will include:

- installation of drainage
- earthworks to form 'spoon' or 'V-style' drainage
- vegetation clearing including trees and shrubbery
- topsoil stripping
- replacement of existing property cross-over culverts
- placement of temporary material to crossovers to accommodate property access.

Property access during works

Properties adjacent to Chambers Flat Road will be temporarily affected by works.

To minimise impacts on households, a member of the SEE Civil project team will contact property owners ahead of work to discuss activities and property access.

What to expect

During construction, you may experience:

- reduced speed limits and traffic changes. For the safety of motorists and workers, temporary traffic changes will occur throughout construction including intermittent traffic controls such as assisted entry and exit to private properties, traffic light controls and direction of traffic control to allow safe movements of plant, heavy vehicles and equipment.
- frequent lane adjustments and changed road alignments
- noise, dust, and vibration
- temporary changes to property access
- odour during asphaltting and sealing works
- increased truck movements
- weather and site conditions may impact works and scheduled start and finish times.
