



PRELIMINARY ADVICE OF UPCOMING ROAD WORKS

Hotz Road Reconstruction Project - Florence Court to Camp Cable Road, Logan Village

On behalf of the City Roads and Water Committee Chair Councillor Phil Pidgeon and Division 4 Councillor Laurie Koranski, Council is proud to provide preliminary advice of upcoming road works at Hotz Road, Logan Village.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Logan City Council is preparing to carry out road reconstruction works on a section of Hotz Road (from Florence Court to Camp Cable Road).

Works will include:

- realignment of the road at the corner to smooth out the bend
- reconstructing the road pavement
- installation of road drainage and open drains
- resurfacing the road with a spray seal finish

Reconstruction works will strengthen the road and improve safety for all users.

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Construction is scheduled to commence in March 2019 and is expected to be completed in November 2019, pending weather and construction conditions.

Works will be carried out from 6.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday, with some weekend works conducted as needed.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Works will be conducted in two stages (see map overleaf):

- Stage 1: Florence Court to Rose Farm Lane
- Stage 2: Rose Farm Lane to Camp Cable Road

Road closures will be required during the works and Council is currently planning the traffic arrangements that will operate. The following traffic changes are proposed:

Stage 1:

- Access to Hotz Road (south of the work zone), Rose Farm Lane and Elanora Court will be via Camp Cable Road.
- Access to Hotz Road (north of the work zone) and remaining side streets will be via Waterford-Tamborine Road.

Stage 2:

- Access to Hotz Road and all side streets will be via Waterford-Tamborine Road only.

Access to properties located adjacent to the work zones will be maintained.

While these proposed traffic arrangements may cause some inconvenience for motorists they are the best way to protect the safety of site workers and motorists.
