# NOTICE OF WORK

SEPTEMBER 2018 - FEBRUARY 2019

## River Hills Road and Brigade Drive Intersection Upgrade (Eagleby)

On behalf of the City Roads and Water Committee Chair Councillor Phil Pidgeon and Division 12 Councillor Jennie Breene, Logan City Council is proud to announce the commencement of the River Hills Road and Brigade Drive Intersection Upgrade.

### WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Intersection upgrade works involve:

- Installing traffic signals at the intersection
- Widening the road pavement on the eastern side of Brigade Drive (south of the intersection)
- Installing turning lanes and cycle lanes on all intersection approaches to accommodate safer turning movements
- Asphalt resurfacing of the intersection and approaches
- Installing new traffic islands and painted chevrons on the intersection approaches
- Installing street lighting, stormwater drainage and sub soil drains
- Associated activities including the relocation of underground services, line marking, footpath works and landscaping.

The works will improve the safety of the intersection for all road users.

Project works are estimated to cost \$3.8 million and are being funded from Council's 2018/19 Capital Roadworks & Drainage Program which has a budget of \$120 million.

Council has appointed Shamrock Civil Engineering Pty Ltd to conduct these works.

### WHERE IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will be carried out in and around the River Hills Road and Brigade Drive intersection at Eagleby (refer to map overleaf).

A construction compound will be established in Council road reserve (adjacent to the work zone) for the duration of the works.

### WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works are scheduled to commence in September 2018 and are expected to be completed in February 2019, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Construction will generally occur from 7.00am to 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday. However, due to the nature of the works, some works may be required outside of these times.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community and motorists during these works. However some localised construction impacts may be experienced including:

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, lane closures and traffic detours. Traffic controllers will be on site during construction working hours to assist motorists and variable message boards will be installed to notify motorists of traffic detour arrangements (as required).
- Temporary traffic congestion and travel delays. Motorists are advised to plan their journey, seek alternative routes (where practical) and allow extra travel time.
- Reduced street parking on River Hills Road to accommodate permanent traffic lane configurations.
- Temporary closure of pedestrian footpaths around the intersection at times. Alternative pedestrian arrangements will be clearly signed.
- Vegetation clearing to accommodate road widening on Brigade Drive.
- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration. The site team will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
