NOTICE OF WORK

SPRAY SEAL WORKS – VEIVERS ROAD, CEDAR CREEK

On behalf of the City Roads and Water Committee Chair Councillor Phil Pidgeon, and Division 4 Councillor Laurie Koranski, Logan City Council is proud to announce the commencement of spray seal works at Cedar Creek.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Localised road pavement repairs and spray seal works will be carried out to resurface Veivers Road, from Beaudesert Beenleigh Road to Chardon Bridge Road, at Cedar Creek (see map overleaf).

The works are funded from Council's 2018/19 Capital Roadworks and Drainage Program, which provides a total budget of approximately \$120 million for roadworks and drainage construction.

Council has appointed Fulton Hogan Industries Pty Ltd to carry out these works.

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Localised pavement repairs are scheduled to occur during the week commencing 14 January 2019 and are expected to take four working days to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.

Works will be conducted from 7.00am to 6.00pm.

Following these repairs, Council's contractor will return in mid-February 2019 to complete spray sealing works. Any line marking and general finishing works will be completed shortly after.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption during these works. However, some localised construction impacts will occur such as:

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, traffic lane closures and / or traffic detours. Site representatives will be available during construction working hours to assist motorists as required.
- Temporary traffic congestion during working hours. Motorists are advised to plan their journey and allow extra travel time (where practical).
- Variable message signs will be installed to provide advanced notification of the works.
- Existing road functions will be reinstated at the end of each shift to accommodate traffic flows.
- Temporary driveway access restrictions at times. Affected residents will be notified in advance to ensure works are coordinated appropriately.
- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration at times. Contractors will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Council's contractor will provide additional notifications to affected residents prior to the commencement of the works.
