



Local Law No. 4 (Animal Management) 2002 and Subordinate Local Law No. 4.1 (Animal Management) 2002 provide residents with consistent rules and recognises our urban, rural and semi-rural lifestyles. Council is committed to ensuring the health and safety of the Logan community.

Under Logan City Council's animal keeping laws, the allowable number of bee hives varies, depending on the size of your property. All bee hives must also be kept in accordance with the Apiaries Act 1982.

Property Size (square metres)	Number of bee hives permitted
0 to 600	Nil
601 to 1,000	1 hive with Logan City Council Approval
1,001 to 2,000	Up to 5 hives with Logan City Council Approval
2,001 to 3,000	Up to 10 hives with Logan City Council approval
More than 3,000	Up to 15 hives with Logan City Council approval

Approvals

To apply for a Bee Keeping Approval, download the application form from the website by visiting logan.qld.gov.au or phone 3412 3412.

Criteria apply to Bee Keeping. Please refer to 'General Requirements'.

Development Approvals

Assessment is required under Council's planning scheme to keep more than fifteen (15) hives, as this is considered a development activity.

Licensing requirements may also exist under Logan's Licensing Local Law or state law.

General requirements

In order to be considered for a Bee Keeping Approval, applicants must demonstrate to Council that the keeping of bees will not result in:

- damage to property
- harm to human health or safety or personal injury
- nuisance
- significant disturbance, inconvenience or annoyance to a person's enjoyment or their place of residence.
