ROADWORKS – BURROWES STATE SCHOOL CARPARK MACARTHY ROAD, MARSDEN

On behalf of the Division 5 Councillor Jon Raven and the Roads and Water Infrastructure Committee Chair Phil Pidgeon, Logan City Council is proud to announce the commencement of the Burrowes State School Carpark Entrance Widening Project.

ACTIVITIES

Project works include:

- Widening the carpark exit to 2 lanes;
- Replacing a section of kerb and channel;
- Constructing a new concrete median;
- Reinstating Linemarking.

LOCATION

The works will be undertaken at the entrance of the school carpark from Macarthy Road, Marsden.

TIMING

Works are planned to commence in December after the school term ends and be completed by the 28th January 2019, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally be undertaken between the hours of 6:30am and 4:00pm, Monday to Friday.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Council will make every effort to minimize disruption to the community during these works. All works will be undertaken in accordance with relevant safety, communication and environmental management plans.

Due to the nature of the works, some localised construction impacts may be experienced. These may include:

- increased levels of noise, dust and vibration adjacent to the construction site; and
- increased truck movements to and from the work site to deliver material and equipment and remove excavated material.

Some temporary traffic changes are also expected. These will include:

- The carpark will be closed during construction.
- Reduced speed limits on Macarthy Road.

Drivers are advised to allow extra time to complete their journey.
