UPCOMING BUS STOP UPGRADES – ROCHEDALE SOUTH

On behalf of Division 1 Councillor Lisa Bradley, Council is proud to announce the commencement of bus stop upgrades in Rochedale South. These works are being completed as part of Council's \$120 million Capital Roads and Drainage Program.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

- **Bus stop upgrades** will occur at:
 - Underwood Road, Rochedale South (outside #880)
 - Parfrey Road, Rochedale South (opposite #147)
 - Parfrey Road, Rochedale South (opposite #119)
 - Exilis Street, Rochedale South (at the side of #2 Hush Place)

These upgrades are jointly funded by Council and the Queensland Government under the 2018/2019 Passenger Transport Accessible Infrastructure Program (PTAIP).

Council has appointed local contractor David Robinson Landscaping Pty Ltd to carry out all works.

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will commence in mid-January 2019 and are expected to be completed in April 2019, weather and site conditions permitting.

A further notice will be delivered in the immediate vicinity of each work site one week ahead of construction commencing.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

While Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption, some localised impacts will occur:

- Speed restrictions, lane closures and footpath closures around work sites at times. Site representatives will be available to assist motorists and pedestrians, as required.
- Temporary loss of street parking and driveway access restrictions. Affected residents will be notified in advance to ensure the works are coordinated appropriately.
- Increased levels of noise and dust at times. Contractors will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Vegetation removal and / or trimming in Council-owned road reserve, as required.
