What is the Logan Community Directory?

The Logan Community Directory is a free online, central directory of community groups, services and facilities available across the City of Logan.

The information in the directory can be accessed by the public, community organisations and government.

The directory provides residents, visitors and organisations the opportunity to easily find contact information for community based services in the local area.

You can view your customised search of organisations, services and facilities in the City of Logan in a list or a map view for free.

Why use the Logan Community Directory ?

The online directory is a valuable resource for individuals and community based organisations to find services in the region and to promote your own services to the community for free.

The directory enables you to:

- Promote your organisation for free
- Find local organisations near you
- Find fast, easy access to current information in the City of Logan
- Be in control of your information.

Registering your Organisation

Registering your organisation on the Logan Community Directory is free for organisations, groups and individuals who provide low cost or free services or programs in the City of Logan.

To get started and register your organisation please visit <http://www.logan.qld.gov.au/logandirectory> and click the 'List for FREE' button.

Managing Your Listing

When you register your organisation on the Directory you will be asked to create a user account.

The user account allows you to manage the 'back end' details of your organisations listing. For example: making updates to your location and updating the services or programs provided.

Once you have logged into your account you can give other people in your organisation authority to also manage your listing. Only the people you authorise will be able to edit your listing.

Do you know about a great organisation or service?

All residents in Logan have the ability to 'Suggest a Listing' if a community organisation/service you know about in Logan is not listed in the directory.

To suggest a listing:

1. Go to the [Logan Community Directory](#)
2. Scroll down to the bottom of the page
3. Under the heading 'Resources' click '[Suggest a Listing](#)'

After you have submitted your suggestion the My Community Directory team will review the listing and if appropriate update the Logan Community Directory with the new listing.

Reporting Incorrect or Out of Date Information

Community members and organisations are able to report incorrect or outdated information in listings on the directory.

If you find incorrect or out of date information we encourage you to report this by following the steps below:

1. On the listing find the 'Report incorrect information' button
2. Complete the short form detailing the incorrect or outdated information on the listing
3. Click submit

For organisation who have registered you can update and correct your own listing through your registered user account. If you come across incorrect information on another organisations listing please use the above steps to provide the correct information.
