FOOTPATH WORKS – KINGSTON & WOODRIDGE

On behalf of Division 2 Councillor Russell Lutton, Logan City Council is proud to announce the commencement of footpath works in Kingston and Woodridge.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Footpath works will be carried out at the following locations:

- **Emperor Court, Kingston** – new footpaths will be installed on both sides of the street and kerb ramps installed on Barossa Street (in front of #40 and #44)
- **Orionis Street, Kingston** – a new footpath will be installed in the odd # side of the street, linking to the pathway in Eridani Park
- **Yalumba Street, Kingston** – a new footpath will be installed on the odd # side of the street to connect with the existing footpath in front of #7
- **Burrigan Street, Woodridge** – a concrete crossover will be installed between #5 and #7 to facilitate vehicle access to the area.

These works are being directly funded out of the Division 2 Infrastructure and Capital Improvement Program.

Council has appointed local contractor David Robinson Landscaping Pty Ltd to carry out all works.

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will commence in June 2018 and are expected to be completed in July 2018, weather and site conditions permitting.

A further notice will be delivered to residents and businesses in the immediate vicinity of each work site approximately one week ahead of construction commencing.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption during these works. However, some localised construction impacts will occur such as:

- Speed restrictions and lane closures around work sites at times. Site representatives will be available to assist motorists as required.
- Temporary loss of street parking and temporary driveway access restrictions at times. Affected residents will be notified in advance to ensure the works are coordinated appropriately.
- Increased levels of noise and dust at times. Contractors will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Temporary closure of pedestrian footpaths during the works. Alternate access will be provided and clearly signed.
- Vegetation removal or pruning in Council-owned road reserve as required.
- If you have a Heavy Vehicle Parking Permit and require allowances for your vehicle during any footpath works, please contact Council to make such arrangements.
