



PRELIMINARY ADVICE OF UPCOMING WORKS

Ludcke Lane Power Pole Relocation Works, Beenleigh

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Logan City Council is planning to upgrade the stormwater infrastructure in the Milne Street, Ludcke Lane and Alamein Street catchment at Beenleigh.

The upgrade is intended to increase the capacity of the local stormwater network and reduce the effects of local flooding in the catchment area.

To facilitate these future works Council is arranging to relocate a power pole within the cul-de-sac at Ludcke Lane, Beenleigh.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

A power pole located in the road reserve outside #5 Ludcke Lane needs to be relocated to make room for future construction works. The pole will be moved to the road reserve between #6 and #8 Ludcke Lane.

Energex will carry out the relocation, which will also include re-feeding house connections to the new power pole. These works are scheduled to occur on Thursday 27 September 2018 (pending project approval and weather conditions).

A temporary power supply interruption will be required during these works. Energex will advise of the timing and expected duration of the temporary supply interruption via a separate notification.

WHEN WILL THE STORMWATER UPGRADE WORKS START?

The upgrade of stormwater infrastructure in your local area is expected to commence in mid-2019 (pending final project approvals). Further information on the timing and nature of these works will be distributed to residents ahead of construction commencing.
