Other disposal methods

- A Asbestos:** Browns Plains only.
30 minutes prior to delivery call council on (07) 3412 4233. Must be double wrapped in thick plastic, manageable size unless in tipping vehicle. Deliver between 8:00am and 3:30pm, regulated waste certification needed if over 250kg.
- B Batteries (household):** Aldi, Battery World, IKEA, Substation 33
Batteries (car): Battery World, Supercheap Auto
Electronic Waste: Substation 33
- C Cartridges:** Cartridge World, Officeworks
- D Coffee pods:** Nespresso stores or Terracycle drop off points, locations can be found on their website:
<https://www.terracycle.com.au/en-AU/>
- E Glasses (eye):** can be taken to some Lions Clubs and optometrists, just call beforehand.
- F Household Paint & Chemical Drop-Off:** check council website for details
- G Medicines:** Old and unused medicines are accepted by most pharmacies for safe disposal.
- H Polystyrene:** Council facilities can not recycle polystyrene even if it displays a number. Please take to Carton Warehouse/Polystyrene Recycling. 105B Colebrad Street West, Acacia Ridge, Monday - Friday, 7:30am-3:00pm. Must be clean, with all stickers and tape removed.
- I Plastic bags/soft plastics:** e.g. bread bags, biscuit packets, pasta & rice bags, cereal inner bags can be recycled by being placed in RedCycle bins at participating supermarkets.
- J Sharps:** All sharps must be placed in a rigid walled and puncture resistant container. There are multiple locations across Logan that accept sharps in an appropriate container. These include most chemists, pharmacies and waste disposal facilities. The full list of participating locations can be found at:
