UPCOMING FOOTPATH WORKS – ELDERBERRY DRIVE, FLAGSTONE

On behalf of Division 11 Councillor Trevina Schwarz, Council is proud to announce the commencement of footpath works in Flagstone.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

New footpath will be installed at Elderberry Drive, Flagstone (on the even side from Branson Street to Dahlia Close).

Some works will extend into side streets and across the road to install kerb ramps across from the new footpath.

These works are being directly funded from the Division 11 Infrastructure and Capital Improvement Program.

Council has appointed local contractor David Robinson Landscaping Pty Ltd to carry out all works.

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will commence in mid-January 2019 and are expected to be completed in April 2019, weather and site conditions permitting.

A further notice will be delivered in the immediate vicinity of each work site one week ahead of construction commencing.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

While Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption, some localised impacts will occur:

- Speed restrictions, lane closures and footpath closures around work sites at times. Site representatives will be available to assist motorists and pedestrians as required.
- Temporary loss of street parking and driveway access restrictions. Affected residents will be notified in advance to ensure the works are coordinated appropriately.
- Increased levels of noise and dust at times. Contractors will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Vegetation removal and / or trimming in Council-owned road reserve.
- If you have a Heavy Vehicle Parking Permit and require allowances for your vehicle during any footpath works, please contact Council to make such arrangements.
