# NOTICE OF WORK

## California Creek Road Kerbing & Drainage Upgrade, Cornubia

On behalf of the City Roads and Water Committee Chair Councillor Phil Pidgeon and Division 10 Councillor Darren Power, Council is proud to announce the commencement of the California Creek Road kerbing and drainage upgrade.

### WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Project works will involve:

- Widening of the road to provide new parking lanes and installation of shelters at bus stops located within the project work zone.
- Installation of new drainage infrastructure including pipes, gully pits and manholes under the road and in Council-owned road reserve areas
- Installation of new kerbing
- Upgrading the footpath from Goodenia Street to Chisholm Catholic College
- Associated works including surfacing of road shoulders, guard rail works and line marking activities (where required).

The works are estimated to cost \$1.3 million and are being funded from Council's 2018/19 Capital Roadworks & Drainage program.

Council has appointed BMD Urban Pty Ltd to carry out the works.

### WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works are scheduled to commence in early January 2019 and are expected to be completed in March 2019. The timing and duration of the works is subject to weather and construction conditions.

Works will generally occur between 7.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday. However, due to the nature of the activities to be performed, some works may be required outside of these hours at times.

### WHERE IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will be carried out on California Creek Road, from Goodenia Street to just past Braddon Street, at Cornubia (see map overleaf for further information).

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community and motorists during these works. However due to the nature of the works, some localised construction impacts will be experienced such as:

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits and lane closures. Traffic controllers will be available during construction working hours to assist motorists as required.
- Temporary loss of street parking adjacent to the work zone for the duration of the works.
- Temporary driveway access restrictions. Affected residents and businesses will be notified in advance so that alternative arrangements can be made.
- Temporary bus stop relocations as required.
- Temporary footpath closures. Signed alternate access arrangements will be provided.
- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration. The site team will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as possible.
- Vegetation removal in and around the work zones.
