ROADWORKS – LIMERICK DRIVE, CRESTMEAD

ACTIVITIES

Logan City Council is commencing a program to replace storm water drainage inlets and selected sections of kerb and channel where required in Limerick Drive, Crestmead.

TIMING

Works will commence in February 2019 and be completed in April 2019, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will be generally occurring between the hours of 6:30am to 3:30pm Monday to Friday.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Due to the nature of the works, some localised construction impacts may be experienced. This may include:

- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration adjacent to the construction site;
- Truck movements to and from the work site to deliver materials and equipment, and remove excavated material;
- Equipment and material may be stored on the footpath;
- Access to driveways will be maintained by placing a steel plate over the work site when works are not being undertaken (see photo); and

- Any disturbance to the footpath will be restored to the original condition however slight variances to aesthetics are unavoidable until the new turf is established.

The Council Construction Team will discuss with residents any issues with property access. We ask you to not walk or drive on the new work for at least 48 hours. We appreciate your patience as we undertake these necessary works.
