# NOTICE OF WORK

## UPCOMING FOOTPATH & BUS STOP WORKS – CORNUBIA, DAISY HILL & SHAILER PARK

On behalf of Division 10 Councillor Darren Power, Council is proud to announce the commencement of footpath and bus stop works in Division 10. These works are being completed as part of Council's \$120 million Capital Roads and Drainage Program.

### WHAT IS HAPPENING?

- **New sections of footpath** will be installed at Roderick Street, Cornubia (on the even side from #38 to #60)

These works are being directly funded from the Division 10 Infrastructure and Capital Improvement Program.

- **Bus stop upgrades** will occur at:
  - Allamanda Drive, Daisy Hill (outside the Daisy Hill Shopping Village)
  - Allamanda Drive, Daisy Hill (outside #53)
  - Bryants Road, Shailer Park (outside #112)
  - Plantain Road, Shailer Park (outside #142)
  - Roselea Street, Shailer Park (outside #50)

These upgrades are jointly funded by Council and the Queensland Government under the 2018/2019 Passenger Transport Accessible Infrastructure Program (PTAIP).

Council has appointed local contractor David Robinson Landscaping Pty Ltd to carry out all works.

### WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will commence in mid-January 2019 and are expected to be completed in April 2019, weather and site conditions permitting.

A further notice will be delivered in the immediate vicinity of each work site one week ahead of construction commencing.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

While Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption, some localised impacts will occur:

- Speed restrictions, lane closures and footpath closures around work sites at times. Site representatives will be available to assist motorists and pedestrians as required.
- Temporary loss of street parking and driveway access restrictions. Affected residents will be notified in advance to ensure the works are coordinated appropriately.
- Increased levels of noise and dust at times. Contractors will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Vegetation removal and / or trimming in Council-owned road reserve.
- If you have a Heavy Vehicle Parking Permit and require allowances for your vehicle during any footpath works, please contact Council to make such arrangements.
