NOTICE OF WORK

February - March 2019

ROAD WORKS – BERYL PARADE, NORTH MACLEAN

WORK

Logan City Council is scheduled to commence a project to widen and seal Beryl Parade, North Maclean.

These works are part of Council's continuing program to improve the road network in our city.

The work will involve:

- minor clearing;
- excavation and pavement construction one metre either side of the existing road to provide a sealed pavement six metres wide; reshaping of existing seal;
- surface with a sprayed bitumen seal.

TIMING

Preliminary works have started and the works proper are planned to commence on Monday 4 February 2019 and be completed by early March 2019, weather and construction conditions permitting.

These works have been planned to ensure as little disruption to traffic as possible, however the majority of the works will be need to be undertaken between the hours of 6:30am to 5:00pm, Monday to Friday.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Council will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community during these works. All works will be undertaken in accordance with relevant safety, communication and environmental management plans.

Due to the nature of the works, some localised construction impacts may be experienced. This may include:

- increased levels of noise, dust and vibration adjacent to the construction site;
- truck movements to and from the works site to deliver materials and equipment and remove excavated material; and
- localised work to your driveway to tie in new works.

Residents will be allowed access throughout this period, with minimal delay. There will be full access overnight and on weekends.
