Logan Wall of Acclaim Criteria

1. An outstanding achievement or a demonstrated commitment to excellence

For example:

- Internationally significant achievement (eg. A world first or scientific development)
- Nationally significant achievement (eg. an Australian first)
- An achievement of great regional significance
- Outstanding performance at an international competition (eg. Sport, Work skills, Award or Performance)
- Outstanding cultural or artistic achievement or contribution at a national or international level

2. Has demonstrated qualities of city ambassadorship

For example:

- Actively displays qualities of ambassadorship (eg. positive references in the media)
- Identifies specifically with the community of Logan

3. Has displayed integrity and character in both their professional and personal lives

For example:

- Held in high regard in the community (Highly regarded)
- Displays inspirational qualities
- Can be described as a leader or role model

4. Has made an outstanding contribution to the community

For example:

- Has made a significant contribution to the development of Logan City
- Long-term volunteer for a Logan-based charity (Highly regarded)
- Long term volunteer for a charity
- A long standing commitment to the development and prosperity of Logan through a business or organisation

5. Is a Logan resident or has a close association to Logan

For example:

- Current Logan resident (Highly regarded)
- Former Logan resident for a minimum 2 years (well regarded)
- Strong association with Logan

Achievements of a purely political or commercial nature will not be considered.
