UPCOMING BUS STOP UPGRADE WORKS – CRESTMEAD

On behalf of Division 9 Councillor Phil Pidgeon, Logan City Council is proud to announce the commencement of bus stop upgrade works in Crestmead. These works are being completed as part of Council's \$109 million Roads and Drainage Capital Program for 2017/2018.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

The following works will be carried out in the local area:

- **Bus stop upgrade works** will be carried out at the following locations:
 - Adjacent #105 Waratah Drive, Crestmead
 - Adjacent #157 Waratah Drive, Crestmead
 - Adjacent #175 Waratah Drive, Crestmead

These upgrades are being jointly funded by Logan City Council and the Queensland Government as part of the 2017/2018 Passenger Transport Accessible Infrastructure Program (PTAIP).

Council has appointed local contractor Enprocon Pty Ltd to carry out the above works.

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

The listed works will commence in October 2017 and are expected to be completed in December 2017, weather and site conditions permitting. A further notice will be delivered to residences and businesses in the immediate vicinity of each work site approximately one week in advance of construction commencing.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community during these works. However, some localised construction impacts will occur such as:

- Speed restrictions and lane closures around works sites at times. Site representatives will be available to assist motorists as required.
- Temporary loss of street parking and temporary driveway access restrictions at times. Affected residents will be notified in advance to ensure the works are coordinated appropriately.
- Increased levels of noise and dust at times. Contractors will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Temporary relocation of bus stops as required.
- Vegetation removal in Council-owned road reserve.
- If you have a Heavy Vehicle Parking Permit for your property and you require allowances for your vehicle during any footpath works, please contact Council to make such arrangements.
