What is the city of Logan's Safe City Strategy and Action Plan 2021-2025?

Logan City Council's City of Logan Safe City Strategy and Action Plan 2021-2025 provides a strategic framework for the coordination and delivery of community safety initiatives across the City of Logan over the next 5 years. This document highlights Council's commitment to creating a safer city. It also demonstrates how Council aims to reduce crime, increase feelings of safety and enhance residents' quality of life, through the delivery of a broad range of community safety initiatives.

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Why does Logan City Council need a Safe City Strategy and Action Plan?

This document has been developed to assist Council in achieving its vision of creating a safer City of Logan and will guide the development of Council's community safety initiatives across the City of Logan over the next 5 years.

Does the Safe City Strategy and Action Plan cover the whole local government area of Logan City Council?

Yes, it has been developed to address community safety issues across the whole Logan City Council local government area.

Council is mindful of different issues affecting different areas of the city and has made it clear through the Strategy and Action Plan that issues will be dealt with proportionately, as required across the city.

How will the Safe City Strategy and Action Plan be implemented?

Council has identified 4 key areas of interest and has developed a broad range of actions that utilise various crime prevention strategies.

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The 4 key areas of interest include:

1. Research and planning
2. Community empowerment
3. Places and spaces
4. Partnerships

How did Logan City Council identify the key areas of interest?

The key areas of interest and subsequent action items have been identified through stakeholder feedback, analysis of Queensland Police Service crime statistics and results from the Safe City Logan community surveys.

How will Logan City Council deliver all of this?

Council acknowledges that we cannot deliver the outcomes on our own and therefore will continue to strengthen existing partnerships and seek to build new collaborations with key government agencies and other community stakeholders. Council already has strong working relationships with a number of community stakeholders and will continue to work collaboratively with our partners toward a shared vision of creating a safer City of Logan.

How will Logan City Council measure success?

To assess the overall success of delivering this Strategy and Action Plan, Council has allocated each action item an individual measure to allow Council to rate its success. These measures will be reported to Council annually by the Community Safety Program to monitor the performance and progress of the overall outcomes of this strategy.
