Logan River Red Bridge Rehabilitation Project

On behalf of the City Roads and Water Committee Chair Councillor Phil Pidgeon and Division 12 Councillor Jennie Breene, Logan City Council is proud to announce the commencement of the Logan River Red Bridge Rehabilitation Project.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

The rehabilitation of the Logan River Red Bridge (from Beenleigh to Loganholme) will involve:

- Concrete and steel bridge repair works
- Repainting the bridge in red

The works will strengthen the bridge structure and enhance its visual appeal.

Project works are estimated to cost \$2.5 million and are being funded from Council's 2018/19 Capital Roadworks & Drainage Program which has a budget of \$120 million.

Council has appointed Allroads Pty Ltd to conduct these works.

WHERE IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will be carried out on the Logan River Red Bridge which is located over the Logan River from Beenleigh to Loganholme.

A construction compound will be established in Logan River Parklands (near the bridge) for the duration of the works.

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works are scheduled to commence in February 2019 and are expected to be completed in June 2019, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Construction will generally occur from 7.00am to 6.00pm, Monday to Friday. However, some night works and weekend works may be required at times.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Council and its contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community during these works. However, some localised construction impacts may be experienced including:

- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration. The site team will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Variable message boards will be installed on either side of the bridge to provide all bridge users with advanced notice of the works.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access to the bridge will be maintained for the majority of the works. However, there will be short-term access restrictions when scaffolding is installed and removed from the work site.
- Lights will be installed on the bridge to increase visibility through the work area.
