Boundary changes & what you need to know

The internal boundaries (divisions) of your Council area are changing.

Council divisions were reviewed by the Local Government Change Commission in 2019, with the boundary changes commencing at the March 2020 election.

The Local Government Change Commission is an independent body that is responsible for ensuring each division of Council has a similar number of enrolled voters at the March 2020 election. This is important in a democracy, as it ensures each person's vote has equal value at the ballot box.

What you can do

If you are enrolled to vote, the ECQ will be posting a Voter Information Card to your address closer to the election which will advise you of your division*.
