## Activity sheet 5 Water samples

Prior to mixing and creating the different samples, ask the students to predict what they will observe. Record their predictions and then compare their actual observations.
Components:
Jug, ice cubes, caster sugar, spoon, salt.
Number each of the following samples:
Mix six teaspoons of salt with two litres of water


Mix six teaspoons of caster sugar with two litres of water


Two litres of carbonated water (mineral or soda)


Two litres of rainwater
If available (boil and cool before sampling)


Two litres of tap water


Two litres of warm tap water


Ice cubes


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Ask the students to taste each sample and describe the taste in one or two words
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Discuss with the students what water is best to drink and why
