

TIPS for dirty water after a water outage

Unexpected events like a broken water main could result in dirty water from your tap. This is due to deposits that build up over time being disturbed by the change in the water flow and direction.

If you have dirty water after an outage we suggest you:

- Run the tap closest to your water meter for up to 5 minutes until the water runs clear. Running a tap for 5 minutes uses about 75 litres of water, which costs about 30 cents.
- If possible, catch the water in a bucket to use on your plants.
- Avoid using your dishwasher or washing machine until the water is clear.
- Call us on 3412 3412 if the water doesn't clear after running a tap for 5 minutes

The water is safe to drink. If there is ever any health risk in the water supply, we will notify you immediately.
