Logan Water is about to commence upgrade works at the Springwood Low Level Reservoir complex

On behalf of Council, Logan Water is pleased to announce the upgrade of the Springwood Low Level Reservoir complex on Springwood Road, Springwood.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Council's Springwood Low Level Reservoir complex is home to two drinking water reservoirs (Reservoir 1 and Reservoir 2 as shown on the map overleaf). Currently, only Reservoir 1 is connected to the water supply network.

Council's Logan Water will undertake structural upgrades and maintenance activities at the reservoir complex ahead of filling Reservoir 2 and connecting it to the water network. Reservoir 1 will then be drained and removed from service.

The upgrades will include internal and external repair works to Reservoir 2 and removal of redundant piping. Additional works will occur in the second half of the year.

This work is required for a safe, reliable and high quality water supply in our city, and to ensure the safety of residents and workers visiting the reservoir complex.

WHERE IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will be carried out within the Springwood Low Level Reservoir complex located on the western side of Springwood Road in Springwood (see map overleaf).

WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will begin during the week of 14 June 2021 and take approximately two months to complete. The timing and duration of the works is subject to construction and weather conditions.

Additional upgrade works will occur in the second half of the year. Further information will be provided ahead of the start of these works.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Logan Water will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community during these works. However, some localised construction impacts may be experienced at times including:



- Temporary closure of the roof covering all of Reservoir 1 and Reservoir 2 to the community for the duration of works. This is to maintain worker and resident safety, and water quality.
- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits and temporary lane closures on Springwood Road during the use of a crane on site.
- Frequent truck movements to and from the site to allow machinery / materials to be delivered and removed.
- Some vegetation removal to make way for construction (this may include the trimming of overhanging branches located in private property). Logan Water will undertake all vegetation removal in accordance with Council and State Government requirements.
- Works will generally occur between 7.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday. However, due to the nature of the works, some weekend works may be required at times.
