### Wastewater (sewerage) pump station and pipeline, Logan Reserve

Division 8 Councillor Jacob Heremaia, with the support of the City Infrastructure ChairTeresa Lane, is pleased to announce the construction of a new wastewater pump station and associated infrastructure in Sungold Road, Logan Reserve.

### What is happening?

Project works will involve the installation of a new wastewaterpump station, 100m of pipeline, five maintenance holes and associated infrastructure including fencing and an access driveway.

# When is it happening?

Vegetation removal on the work site will commence in early August 2020.
Construction will commence in mid-August 2021 and is expected to be completed by June 2022.
Construction will generally occur between 6.30am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday. However due the nature of the works, some activities may be required outside of these times. The timing of works is subject to construction and weather conditions

# Where is it happening?

The pump station will be constructed in

Council acquired land in Sungold Road (next to the greenhouses on the corner of Chambers Flat Road). See map overleaf.

The pipeline will be constructed in developer owned land and in the road reserve to connect to current infrastructure in Sungold Road, Logan Reserve.

#### What can I expect?

Logan Water will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community and environment during these works.

However, some localised construction impacts are expected including:

- Clearing of vegetation in the work zone in accordancewith Council and State Government requirements.
- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration. The site team will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
- Frequent truck movements to and from the work site to allow machinery / materials to be delivered and excavated materials removed.



 Changed traffic conditions on Sungold Road including reduced speed limits and possible temporary lane closures at times.

Full restoration of the work zone (such as turfing and concreting etc.) will occur when construction is complete.
