## ALBERT STREET INTERSECTION UPGRADES - BETHANIA

**Division 6 Councillor Tony Hall with the support of the City Infrastructure Chair and Division 2 Councillor Teresa Lane, is pleased to advise that project works will start next month.**

### WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Logan City Council is upgrading the Albert Street / Station Road and Albert Street / Church Road intersections with signalised traffic lights to improve the safety and condition of the road for all road users. Project works will involve:

- Upgraded intersections controlled by traffic lights.
- Installation of additional turning lanes.
- Dedicated on-road cycleways through the intersections.
- Construction of new road surface.
- Kerb / channel and footpaths upgrades.
- Associated activities including line marking, installation of traffic signage and street lighting and landscaping works.

Project works are estimated to cost \$2.6 million and are being jointly funded from Council's Major Roads Program and the Australian Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program.

We have appointed Doval Constructions (QLD) to conduct these works.

### WHEN IS IT HAPPENING?

Works are scheduled to commence in January 2022 and are expected to be completed in April 2022, subject to weather and construction conditions.

**To reduce traffic impacts on this busy road, works will be carried out at night between 8:00pm to 5:00am, Sunday to Friday. Please note, works will not be carried out for more than two consecutive nights in a row.**

### WHERE IS IT HAPPENING?

Works will be carried out around the intersections, from Church Road to end of the Albert Street cul-de-sac (refer to map overleaf).

A construction compound will be established near the work zone for the duration of the works.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Our contractor will make every effort to minimise disruption during these works. However, some localised construction impacts may be experienced including:

- Changed traffic conditions including speed restrictions, temporary lane closures and traffic detours (as required). Traffic controllers will be on site during construction working hours to assist motorists.

- Electronic signs will be installed prior to works starting to notify motorists of the traffic arrangements.
- Temporary traffic congestion during working hours. Motorists are advised to plan their journey, seek alternative routes (where practical), and allow extra travel time.
- Driveway access restrictions at times as works are carried out in front of driveway entrances. Affected residents / businesses will be notified in advance and alternative arrangements made.
- Temporary footpath closures. Pedestrian access will be clearly signed, and site representatives available to assist as needed.

- Minor vegetation removal within the work zone.
- Increased levels of noise, dust, vibration, and lighting. The site team will implement measures to reduce these impacts as much as practical.
