Goodna Road Upgrade and New Beith Road Upgrade

Alignment Options | Have Your Say March 2022

We will soon be assessing options to improve Goodna Road (Middle Road to Thompson Road) and New Beith Road (Hobury Road to Goodna Road).

This is a major improvement to Greenbank's road network and we want to hear from you on what you feel is important when considering the potential options.

Project overview

With Logan's population growing, traffic numbers in Greenbank and the surrounding area are expected to increase.

The improvements are aimed at ensuring the road network can safely and effectively accommodate this rising traffic demand.

Options being considered include:

- upgrading the current road alignment on the relevant sections of Goodna Road and New Beith Road
- a new alignment bypassing Greenbank State School (directly linking New Beith Road with both Middle Road and Ison Road)
- an alternative location for the Goodna Road / New Beith Road intersection.

The chosen solution may incorporate portions of each option

to improve connectivity, traffic flow and travel times.

Maps highlighting the potential alignment corridors are included overleaf.

Project benefits

- improved safety as traffic increases
- less congestion and more reliable travel times as traffic increases
- reduce the impacts of flooding on the road network
- improved connectivity to Springfield and beyond
- better and safer walking and cycling opportunities.

We are committed to protecting the local environment and heritage sites while we deliver essential road upgrades in the Greenbank area.


Project assessments will be considering the impact to the environment, including carrying out a range of environmental surveys as well as cultural heritage investigations.
