Loganlea Road Major Upgrade

Logan City Council is delivering a 2.3 km upgrade of Loganlea Road, from the Logan Motorway, Meadowbrook to the Pacific Motorway, Slacks Creek to reduce congestion and help get you home safely.



What is happening?

We're undertaking a major widening project on Loganlea Road from just south of University Drive at Meadowbrook, to the Pacific Motorway on ramp at Slacks Creek.

The project will include:

- > widening Loganlea Road to 3 lanes in both directions
- > addition of a new northbound lane and shared path on the Ray Hodgson Bridge
- > installing new stormwater infrastructure and kerbing to improve road and verge drainage
- > new shared pathway northbound and upgrades to the existing southern pathway
- > new and upgraded traffic signals at intersections
- > new and upgraded bus stops
- installing fauna protection fencing from Queens Road to the Slacks Creek Environmental Park
- > some vegetation removal and tree trimming
- > associated works including relocation of water and electrical services and restoration activities.


We have appointed **SEE Civil** to undertake these \$80 million works. This project is being delivered under our Major Roads Program and is funded in part by the Australian Government through the *Investment Road and Rail Program*.

When is it happening?

Main construction will commence from April 2023. Works are expected to be completed by late 2024, pending site and weather conditions.

Construction activities will generally occur from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday to Saturday. If works are required to be completed outside of these hours, nearby residents will be notified.





What can I expect?



Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected. Motorists are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

Impacts

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, some shoulder/lane closures and detours (as needed).
- > Electronic signs will be installed to communicate traffic changes.
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration.
- > Temporary loss of street parking and driveway access.
- ightarrow Temporary footpath closures and bus stop relocations.
- > Temporary water, sewer and power disruptions.

What we are doing

- > Traffic controllers will be available for detours and road/lane closures as required.
- > Affected residents will be notified in advance of changes to parking and driveway access, footpath or bus stop relocation, or temporary water, sewer or power interruptions.

Logan's road network commitment

The Loganlea Road Major Upgrade

(Meadowbrook to Slacks Creek) is part of Council's \$850 million investment in roads and transport solutions from 2022–2026/27 to keep Logan moving.

Ongoing economic growth in Logan and across the region means we're delivering a sustainable and reliable transport network.

With our city's population set to increase by more than 50 per cent by 2041, improving our road network is one of the ways we are unlocking Logan's potential and preparing for the future.

Other major upgrade projects include Chambers Flat Road from Mount Lindesay Highway to Kings Way, Mundoolun Road, Middle Road and Teviot Road roundabout.



What happens next?

April 2023

Main construction

Works will be undertaken in multiple stages.

Activities include construction of new lanes, bridge extension and strengthening, installation of new median, road resurfacing and landscape restoration activities.
