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# Logan City Council Subordinate Local Law No. 12.5 (Waste Management Facilities) 2003

## Part 1 Preliminary

### 1 Short title

This subordinate local law may be cited as *Subordinate Local Law No. 12.5 (Waste Management Facilities) 2003*.

### 2 Authorising local law

This subordinate local law is made pursuant to *Local Law No. 12 (Council Property and Other Public Places) 2003*.

### 3 Object

The object of this subordinate local law is to assist in the implementation of *Local Law No. 12 (Council Property and Other Public Places) 2003* by specifying pursuant to section 9(1) (Regulation of council property) of *Local Law No. 12 (Council Property and Other Public Places) 2003* restrictions on the use of a waste management facility.

### 4 Definitions—the dictionary

The dictionary in Schedule 3 (Dictionary) of this subordinate local law defines particular words used in this subordinate local law.

## Part 2 Visitors to waste management facility

### 5 Admission to restricted area

A person must not enter a restricted area unless authorised by—

- (a) the prior written approval of the local government; or
- (b) a direction of an authorised person.

### 6 Regulated conduct

A person must not—

- (a) use indecent, obscene, insulting or threatening language in a waste management facility; or

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- (b) behave in an offensive, threatening or indecent manner in a waste management facility; or
- (c) by disorderly conduct cause serious alarm or affront to a person in a waste management facility; or
- (d) obstruct a council officer in the performance of that council officer's work or duties in a waste management facility; or
- (e) cause annoyance or inconvenience to any other person in a waste management facility; or
- (f) stand or loiter to the inconvenience, annoyance or obstruction of any person in the waste management facility; or
- (g) carry or convey any article or substance of an offensive or indecent character or any article of any length or dimension as to be an inconvenience, obstruction, hazard or danger to any person in a waste management facility, other than an article or substance intended to be lawfully disposed of at the waste management facility; or
- (h) place or cause or permit to be placed in a waste management facility anything whatsoever so as to be an inconvenience, obstruction, hazard or danger to any person in a waste management facility; or
- (i) push into any line of persons in a waste management facility that has been fixed by an authorised person; or
- (j) obstruct, hinder or prevent the free passage of any person or vehicle in a waste management facility; or
- (k) do or say anything to hinder or interfere with the proper progress or conduct of an authorised activity in a waste management facility; or
- (l) contravene any restriction to which the person's entry to a waste management facility was subject; or
- (m) enter any part of a waste management facility when excluded or banned by the direction of an authorised person; or
- (n) before leaving a waste management facility, fail to pay any applicable waste disposal fee; or
- (o) dispose of prohibited waste at a waste management facility; or
- (p) allow a person, who is a minor under their control, to be unsupervised in an operational area.

**7 Recreational activities**

A person (other than a council officer acting in the course of the council officer's employment) must not, unless authorised by the prior written approval of the local government or a direction of an authorised person—

- (a) make an address or conduct or hold a meeting or any other event, in a waste management facility; or
- (b) operate any radio, cassette or other audio player, or play any musical instrument at a volume likely to cause annoyance or inconvenience to any person in a waste management facility; or
- (c) drive, stand, wheel or park any regulated vehicle in a manner likely to cause annoyance or inconvenience to any person in a waste management facility; or
- (d) operate or use an amplifier device in a waste management facility; or
- (e) cause or allow any animal (other than a guide dog, hearing dog or assistance dog) to be in a waste management facility unless the animal is restrained in the person's vehicle.

**8 Smoking**

A person must not smoke within any part of a waste management facility other than in a designated smoking area.

**9 Interference with signs**

A person (other than a council officer acting in the course of the council officer's employment) must not interfere with any sign exhibited in a waste management facility.

**10 Directions**

A person must comply with a direction of an authorised person made or given for the purpose of securing the good order or management of a waste management facility.

**11 Distribution of publications**

A person (other than a council officer acting in the course of the council officer's employment) must not distribute a publication in a waste management facility or publicise a publication in a waste management facility or engage in any promotional activity unless authorised by—

- (a) the prior written approval of the local government; or

- (b) a direction of an authorised person.

**12 Interference with a waste management facility**

A person (other than a council officer acting in the course of the council officer's employment) must not, unless authorised by the prior written approval of the local government, interfere with—

- (a) a council asset in a waste management facility; or  
(b) a waste management facility.

**13 Erection of structures**

A person (other than a council officer acting in the course of the council officer's employment) must not erect any building, structure, stall, booth, tent or bar in a waste management facility, unless authorised by the prior written approval of the local government.

**Part 3 Vehicles in waste management facility**

**14 Access by vehicles**

A person must not, unless authorised by the prior written approval of the local government or a direction of an authorised person, drive, lead, stand, wheel or park a vehicle in a waste management facility other than in—

- (a) a designated vehicle area; or  
(b) an area which is intended to be used for public access by a vehicle.

**15 Compliance with signs**

A person must not, unless authorised by the prior written approval of the local government or a direction of an authorised person, cause a vehicle to be driven, lead, stood, wheeled or parked contrary to a sign in a waste management facility.



section 4

***amplifier device*** means—

- (a) a loud hailer; or
- (b) a megaphone; or
- (c) a public address system; or
- (d) a remote telephone bell; or
- (e) a telephone repeater bell.

***assistance dog*** has the meaning given in the *Guide, Hearing and Assistance Dogs Act 2009*.

***authorised activity*** means an activity authorised by the local government or an authorised person to occur in a waste management facility.

***council officer*** has the meaning given in *Local Law No. 2 (Administration) 2010*.

***designated vehicle area*** means the area which may be used for driving, leading, standing, wheeling or parking a vehicle in a waste management facility that is specified by a sign or as directed by a council officer.

***guide dog*** has the meaning given in the *Guide, Hearing and Assistance Dogs Act 2009*.

***hazard*** has the meaning given in *Local Law No. 2 (Administration) 2010*.

***hearing dog*** has the meaning given in the *Guide, Hearing and Assistance Dogs Act 2009*.

***minor*** means a person who is less than 16 years of age.

***operational area*** means that area of a waste management facility designated as an operational area by the local government and specified by a sign exhibited in a waste management facility or as directed by a council officer.

***prohibited waste*** means any waste, the disposal of which is prohibited at a waste management facility as specified by a sign exhibited at a waste management facility.

***public area*** means any part of a waste management facility that—

- (a) is used for the purpose of a foyer, walkway or other facility of a public nature; or

(b) is a designated vehicle area available for use by the public.

***restricted area*** means—

- (a) any part of a waste management facility that is not a public area; and
- (b) any part of a waste management facility (including a public area) that is specified as a restricted area by a sign or an authorised person.

***waste*** has the meaning given in the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*.

***waste management facility*** means the premises specified in Schedule 1 (Waste management facilities) of this subordinate local law.

***waste disposal fee*** means a general charge in respect of the disposal of waste at a waste management facility.
