East Street to Monmouth Court and John Collins Drive to Collins Creek Road 2023



### **Mundoolun Road Rehabilitation**

Division 9 Councillor Scott Bannon, with the support of Councillor Teresa Lane, Chair of the City Infrastructure Committee, is pleased to announce the commencement of these works.

We are upgrading 4.5 kilometres of Mundoolun Road, from south of the East Street/Edelsten Road roundabout to just north of Monmouth Court, and from John Collins Drive to Collins Creek Road.

This means a smoother road with wider lanes and shoulders, improved flood immunity and better intersections to keep you moving.

The upgrade will:



Unlock local bottlenecks to keep you moving



Improve safety as traffic grows



Reduce the frequency and duration of road closures due to flood events.

## When is it happening

Main works will commence from early 2023, and are expected to be completed in late 2023, pending site and weather conditions. Construction activities will generally occur from 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday. Some works may occur outside of these hours, residents will be advised.

# Less disruption, faster delivery

We have appointed **Doval Constructions (Qld) Ltd** to undertake these works. To reduce the duration of construction, multiple crews will be working across the project zone. This will speed up the works and minimise disruption to the community.

## What is changing


To maintain safety as traffic increases, we're making changes to parts of Mundoolun Road.


#### This means:

- raising the road in some sections to improve flood resilience
- > improving road curves
- > widening lanes and building wider shoulders
- > road resurfacing in some sections
- > improving drainage
- > minor changes at some intersections to make turning easier for heavy vehicles.

### What can I expect

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected such as:

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, road/lane closures and detours (as needed). Traffic controllers will assist during working hours.
- Electronic signs will be installed to communicate traffic changes.
  Motorists are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration.
- Temporary disruption to driveway access. Affected residents will be notified in advance.
- > Bus stop relocation. Changes will be signed.




# Our road network commitment

The Mundoolun Road Rehabilitation is part of Council's \$715 million investment in roads and transport solutions to 2026 to keep Logan moving.

Ongoing economic growth in Logan and across the region means we're delivering a sustainable and reliable transport network to meet the needs of all users.

With our population set to almost double by 2041, including the expected growth of Park Ridge and Logan Reserve, improving our road network is one of the ways we are unlocking Logan's potential and preparing for the future.

Other major upgrade projects include Chambers Flat Road from Mt. Lindesay Highway to Kings Way, Middle Road and Teviot Road roundabout and Loganlea Road.
