

Grand Plaza Drive and Eastern Road Shared Pathway Project

Waller Park to Mt Lindesay Highway Service Road, Browns Plains



We are shaping a greener, healthier city with a new link in our shared path network at Browns Plains.

Better off-road paths and improved local access means more opportunities for easier recreation and commuting.



Create safer active travel opportunities and more reliable travel times.



Link to other on-road shared pathways on Mount Lindesay Highway Service Road and in Mount Waller Park.



Deliver greater connectivity to local public transport, shopping centre precincts, educational facilities and more.

What is happening?

The shared pathway upgrade along Grand Plaza Drive and Eastern Road, Browns Plains will include:

- › a safer and more accessible 2.5m wide shared pathway for pedestrians and biker riders
- › raised crossings to prioritise access for pedestrians and biker riders
- › upgraded kerb ramps to provide smoother access between the road and the path
- › dedicated bike lanes for improved safety and visibility
- › landscaping enhancements along the shared pathway.


This project is proudly supported by the Transport Infrastructure Development Scheme.

Logan City Council has appointed a contractor to undertake these works. Local residents and businesses will be advised before construction starts.

Waller Park to Mt Lindesay Highway Service Road, Browns Plains



When is it happening?

Construction is expected from early 2024. Works are anticipated to be completed by mid 2024, weather and site conditions permitting.

To minimise disruptions to local businesses, majority of the works will take place at night. Activities will generally occur from 7 pm to 5 am Friday to Wednesday, and 9 pm to 5 am on Thursday along Grand Plaza Drive. Some days works will be required along Eastern Road. If works are required outside these hours, nearby residents and businesses will be notified.

What can I expect?

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected. Motorists and path users are encouraged to plan their journeys and allow extra travel time

Temporary impacts

- › Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, lane closure and detours (as needed).
- › Increased noise, dust, and vibration.
- › Temporary loss of street parking and driveway access.
- › Temporary footpath closures and possible bus stop relocation.

What are we doing?

- › Traffic controllers will be available for detours and lane closures during working hours.
- › Electronic and printed signs will be installed to communicate traffic and footpath changes.
- › Affected residents and path users will be notified in advance of changes to parking and driveway access, footpath or bus stop relocations.

Our road network commitment

The Grand Plaza Drive and Eastern Road Shared Pathway project is part of Council's substantial investment in roads and transport solutions to keep Logan moving.

Ongoing economic growth in Logan and across the region means we need to deliver a sustainable and reliable transport network. With our population set to almost double by 2041, including the expected growth of Browns Plains and surrounds, improving our active transport network is one of the ways we are unlocking Logan's potential and preparing for the future.
