Construction Update Chambers Flat Road Upgrade

October 2023

SEE Civil is the appointed contractor to construct the 3.8 km Chambers Flat Road upgrade between Mount Lindesay Highway to just north of Kings Way.

Traffic changes

Motorists are welcoming two key milestones delivered ahead of schedule.

The Kings Way intersection upgrade right turn into Chambers Flat Road has re-opened, cancelling a 3.8 km detour.

Traffic has switched to 1.2 kms of the new asphalted lane from the upgraded Norris Creek Road intersection to Munruben Ambulance Station.

Current works

Zone 1 and 2

- constructing driveway access ramps to the new road alignment
- > installing road and driveway drainage
- > earthworks requiring plant and truck activity
- > constructing Norris Creek Road intersection
- > sealing and asphalting
- > moving plant and equipment
- > road reserve works
- > landscaping.

Zone 3 – Norris Creek Bridge

- > building a temporary working platform
- > piling works for internal and end bridge supports
- > works due to start mid-October and continue into November
- > residents can expect noise and vibration.

Zone 4

- reconstructing Kings Way paving and road reserve works
- > undertaking intersection tie in works to the new section of Chambers Flat Road
- > vegetation clearing and grubbing
- constructing driveway access ramps to the new alignment
- > installing road and driveway drainage
- > earthworks requiring plant and truck activity
- > moving plant and equipment
- > relocating the watermain.

What to expect

- > temporary traffic changes reduced speed, assisted property access, traffic controls and direction of traffic to allow shifting of plant and equipment
- > frequent lane adjustments and changed road alignments
- letterbox notification of any interruptions to water supply
- > odour during asphalting and sealing works
- > increased truck movements
- > temporary changes to property access
- > changes to waste bin collection to accommodate the eastbound closure
- > increased noise, dust and vibration
- > weather and site conditions may impact scheduled work hours
- > drone flights will occur intermittently throughout the project to capture progress.
