Disaster assistance and grants

If you have been directly impacted by a natural disaster, you may be eligible to apply for the following loans, grants and assistance to help speed your recovery.

Personal Hardship

Assistance

Emergency Hardship Assistance

grants — \$180 per person, up to \$900 for a family of 5 or more.

Essential Services Hardship

Assistance grant — \$150 per person, up to \$750 for a family of 5 or more.

Essential Household Content grants —

up to \$1,765 for single adults and up to \$5,300 for couples/families, subject to an income test.

Structural Assistance grants —

up to \$50,000 per household, subject to an income test.

Essential Services Safety and

Reconnection grant — up to \$200 towards a safety inspection for each essential service needing reconnection and up to \$4,200 towards repair work to enable essential services to be reconnected, subject to an income test.

Assistance

Businesses and not-for-profits in the Logan, Scenic Rim and Gold Coast local government areas may be eligible for disaster assistance:

Disaster assistance loan up to \$250,000 for small businesses and \$100,000 for not-forprofits to help repair or replace damaged assets like plant and equipment, or to repair premises.

Primary Producers Assistance

Primary producers may be eligible for a Disaster assistance loan up to \$250,000 to help repair or replace damaged assets, including stock, and maintain liquidity.

You may also be eligible for an **Essential** working capital loan of up to \$100,000 from QRIDA to help you continue operating.
