

Loganlea Road Major Upgrade

Project update, October 2024

SEE Civil is the appointed contractor for Logan City Council's Loganlea Road upgrade. We're undertaking 2.3kms of widening works from University Drive at Meadowbrook to the Pacific Motorway/M1 at Slacks Creek. This major project means more reliable travel times, safer intersections, and better connectivity for Logan's southwest.

Traffic switch

On Sunday 8 September 2024, Loganlea Road Major Upgrade achieved a significant milestone with yet another traffic switch onto the newly constructed southbound lanes

Relocating the traffic has allowed us to focus on upgrading the middle section of road and complete the last of the full-depth pavements.



University Drive – slip lane closure

We recently closed the left-turn slip lanes on University Drive, to allow access to complete full-depth pavement works.

Closing the slip lanes over the weekend, helped to speed up completion of the works.

Be prepared

- > For safety, follow instructions of work crews and road signage.
- > Keep children, equipment and materials clear of the work zone.
- > Follow signage and pedestrian paths and remain inside flagged pathways.
- > Drive to conditions and be aware of any upcoming changes.

Progress update – Southbound

- > Currently constructing the new southbound alignment and shared pathway.
- > There will be new turn lanes at Ellerslie Road, Queens Road, and Golf Course Drive.
- > An intersection upgrade at Golf Course Drive.
- > Resurfacing and line marking of the new southbound lanes.
- > Installing stormwater drainage, conduiting for street lighting, and new fauna fencing on both sides of the road from Queens Road to Slacks Creek Enviro Park.
- > New landscaping and installing signage.
- > Changes to shared footpaths, and installing guardrails.
- > Removal of central road kerbs and garden beds.
- > Constructing the central section to tie into the new northbound and southbound lanes.
- > Installing full-depths pavement.
- > New stormwater drainage installed.
- > Driveway access at the Shell Service Station.
- > Upgrading University Drive and Ellerslie Road.



Koala breeding season – take care!

What can I expect?

- > Temporary traffic changes – expect detours and follow signed directions.
- > Possible odour during asphaltting and sealing works.
- > Potential increased truck and heavy vehicle movements.
- > Temporary changes to property access.
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > Crews watering the area for dust control.
- > Drone flights intermittently to capture progress and assist engineers.
- > Intermittent night works until the end of the project.
- > Stockpiling of materials in the road reserve.
