

### Dr Karl

Science communicator and author Main Stage, 12:15 pm – 1:15 pm Book Signing, Meet & Greet Zone, 1:40 pm – 2:30 pm

Dr. Karl Kruszelnicki AM, known as Dr Karl, is a renowned Australian science communicator with over thirty years of experience, 48 books and a TV show called "How Things Work" on ABC TV and iView. He holds degrees in physics, mathematics, biomedical engineering, medicine, and surgery and has received many accolades including the 2025 NSW Senior Australian of the Year.



### Dr Chadden Hunter Wildlife biologist and filmmaker

Dr. Chadden Hunter is a Brisbane-based wildlife biologist and filmmaker who has spent the last two decades working with Sir David Attenborough. After completing a PhD on Ethiopian monkeys, he worked with the BBC and National Geographic, filming diverse wildlife. His series, including Planet Earth 1 and 2, Frozen Planet, and The Platypus Guardian on ABC iView, have won twenty Emmy and Bafta awards.



#### Ranger Stacey

Media personality, wildlife communicator, writer and environmental educator

Stacey Thomson, known as Ranger Stacey, is a beloved Australian television personality and wildlife communicator who began her career as a ranger in 1984. 
#### **Belinda Humphrey**
