

Park Ridge Road, Clarke Road/ Lindenthal Road Intersection Upgrade

Park Ridge



We are improving road safety with support from the Australian Government.

This intersection upgrade will help reduce the risk of crashes and improve safety for all road users.

This upgrade means:



a safer intersection



more reliable travel times



improved traffic flow and reduced congestion

What is happening?

This intersection upgrade will help reduce the risk of potential crashes and enhance safety for all road users.

Features include:

- > constructing new footpaths, kerb and channel near the intersection
- > upgrading stormwater drainage in the intersection
- > new pedestrian path and raised signalised crossing
- $\, \succ \,$ installing traffic signals and street lighting
- > line marking and signage.

We have appointed DOVAL Constructions (QLD) Ltd to undertake these upgrade works.

When is it happening?

Construction is scheduled to commence in September 2024, pending construction and weather conditions.

Activities will generally occur between 7:00am and 6:00pm Monday to Saturday, excluding public holidays.

If works are required outside these hours, nearby residents will be notified.



What can I expect?



Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected. Road users are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

Temporary impacts

- Changed traffic conditions including detours, reduced speed limits and road or lane closures (as needed)
- > increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > temporary footpath closures.

What are we doing?

- Traffic controllers will be available during working hours.
- > electronic signs will be in place.
- > affected residents will be notified.

Project funding



This project is being delivered with support from the Australian Government's Black Spot Program. The Black Spot Program was introduced as part of the Australian Government's commitment to reduce crashes. The program targets locations where crashes have occurred or are at high risk of happening.

Other local Black Spot program upgrades include:

- > Teviot Road and Cusack Lane intersection Black Spot Project, South MacLean and Riverbend
- Chambers Flat Road (Holloway Road to Kenny Road) Black Spot Project, Chambers Flat
- > Millstream Road Black Spot Project, Cedar Vale.
