# SURVEY WORKS | MILLSTREAM ROAD, CEDAR VALE | BLACK SPOT PROGRAM

Logan City Council is investigating potential safety improvements for Millstream Road between Jarrah Road and Barnes Road with support from the Australian Government's Black Spot Program.

The Black Spot Program was introduced as part of the Australian Government's commitment to reduce crashes. The program directly targets roads with a proven crash history or high-risk locations.

#### Need for this project

In the period from 2016 to 2020, this section of road recorded 9 crashes that resulted in minor injury, medical treatment, or hospitalisation.

We are committed to improving road safety across Logan. This upgrade will help deliver a safer road by reducing the risk of potential future crashes.

#### Project details and benefits

To make the location safer, we will investigate:

- road shoulder widening at selected locations, and along most of the southern sections of Millstream Road
- the installation of guardrails on sharp bends
- resurfacing Millstream Road from Jarrah Road to Banksia Road to improve surface grip
- upgrading line markings to better delineate lanes and the edge of the road
- new and improved signage, including warning signs and guidepost reflectors.

### Investigation work

Over the next 3 months our survey team will be working in the road reserve to undertake land surveys. These surveys will allow the design team to confirm which safety improvements are able to be designed and constructed.

To ensure our crews and road users are kept safe, traffic management may be in place. This may lead to some local queuing, and we thank you for your patience.

# Next steps

The safety investigation is expected to continue through to the end of 2022. We will confirm what safety improvements will be delivered in a future update to the community.
