

# High Road, Easterly Street and Old Logan Village Road Upgrade

**Division 4 Councillor Nathan St Ledger, together with Committee Chair for City Shape, Economic Transformation and Transport Committee, Deputy Mayor Scott Bannan, is pleased to let you know that works are planned for your area.**

This upgrade means:



Safer active travel



Improved road drainage



Formalised street parking

## What is happening?

We will soon start works to upgrade sections of High Road, Easterly Street and Old Logan Village Road adjacent to Canterbury College, to improve drainage and parking around the school, while creating safer active travel opportunities.

The project is jointly funded with the Queensland Government South East Queensland Community Stimulus Program.

We have appointed Doval to undertake these works.

## When is it happening?

Construction will take place from August 2026 to April 2027, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Activities will generally occur from Monday to Friday, 9 am to 2 pm on school days and from 7 pm to 5 am for night works. Nearby residents will be notified before works start and if we need to work outside normal hours.



## What can I expect?

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected. Motorists and path users are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

### Temporary Impacts

- > Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, lane closures and detours (as needed).
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > Temporary loss of street parking and driveway access.
- > Temporary footpath closures and bus stop relocation.
- > Possible short telecommunication outages due to raising/lowering some communication pits.

### What we are doing

- > Traffic controllers will be available for detours and road/lane closures during working hours.
- > Electronic signs will be installed to communicate traffic changes.
- > Affected residents and path users will be notified in advance of changes to parking and driveway access, footpath or bus stop relocations.



## Our road network commitment

With our city's population set to increase by more than 60 per cent by 2046, including the expected growth of Flagstone and Riverbend, improving our road network is one of the ways we're unlocking Logan's potential and preparing for the future.
