

Bumstead Road and Julie Street Intersection Upgrade

Crestmead and Park Ridge



We're upgrading the intersection at Bumstead Road and Julie Street at Crestmead and Park Ridge, with support from the Australian Government's Black Spot Program.

This upgrade will help reduce the risk of crashes and improve safety for all road users.

This upgrade means:



A safer and more accessible environment for everyone



Better traffic flow



Quicker and more reliable travel times

What is happening ?

We are upgrading the intersection at Bumstead Road and Julie Street.

To help make this intersection safer, we will:


- > install new traffic and pedestrian crossing signals for safer crossings and traffic flow.
- > add new street lights for better visibility
- > add a right turn lane on Bumstead Road into Julie Street
- > create dedicated on-road bike lanes for safer active transport
- > add a new footpath on Bumstead Road for safer pedestrian access
- > upgrade stormwater drainage
- > resurface and restore the road for a safer and smoother experience
- > build raised pedestrian crossings into and out of Julie Street for better pedestrian visibility.

When is it happening ?

Construction is scheduled to begin in February 2026 and will take approximately 4 months (pending site and weather conditions).

Generally, work activities will occur Monday to Friday, 7 am to 5 pm (excluding public holidays).

We'll let nearby residents and businesses know if we need to work outside these hours.



What can I expect ?

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. Please plan your journey and allow extra travel time.

Temporary Impacts

- > Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, road or lane closures and detours.
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration.
- > Temporary loss of street parking.
- > Temporary footpath closures.

What we are doing

- > Traffic controllers will be available during working hours.
- > Electronic signs will be installed.
- > Affected properties or businesses will be notified.

Project Funding

This project is being delivered with support from the Australian Government's Black Spot Program. The program targets locations where crashes have occurred or are at risk of happening.

We are committed to improving road safety across Logan. This upgrade will help deliver a safer intersection by reducing the risk of potential future crashes.
