

# Woodlands Drive Master Drainage Upgrade

Underwood Road to Hartog Place

This upgrade means:



Helping to protect people and property



Allowing stormwater to drain more efficiently



Building a more resilient and reliable stormwater network

## What is happening?

We are delivering a major stormwater upgrade across Rochedale South. Commencing in 2020, this complex upgrade is being delivered over multiple streets in stages across the project zone.

We are now preparing the next stage of works on Woodlands Drive, from Underwood Road to Hartog Place:

- › install new drainage infrastructure including large pipelines, maintenance holes and culverts
- › improvement works at drainage outlets
- › replace sections of kerb and footpath, where needed
- › service relocation works
- › resurface impacted streets.

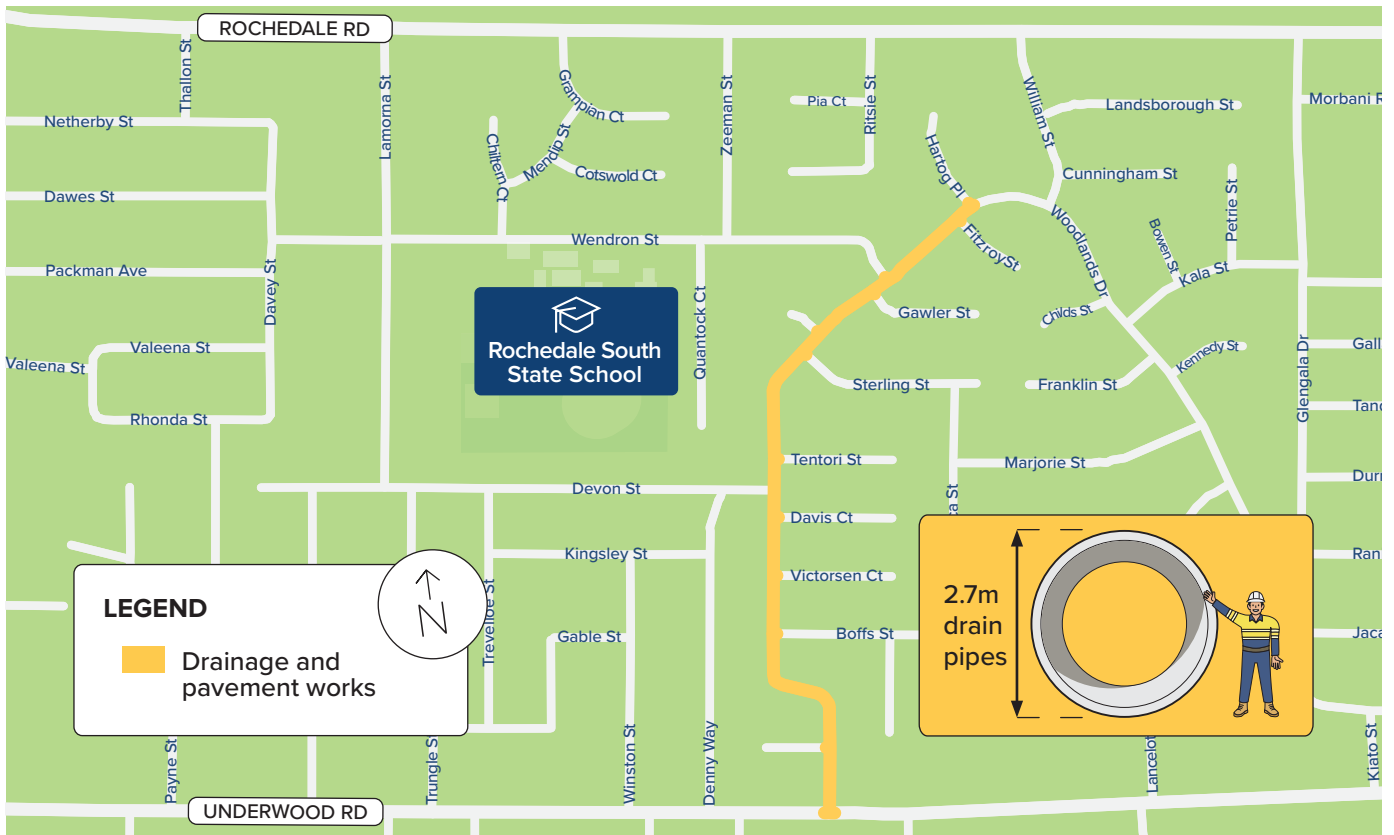
We have appointed Doval Constructions to complete these works.

## When is it happening ?

Construction is scheduled to start in **mid-June 2026** and will take approximately 12 months. Please keep in mind wet weather and unforeseen construction conditions can cause delays to this timeframe.

Works will occur **Monday to Friday, 7 am to 5 pm** (excluding public holidays).

We will let you know if work is required outside these hours.



## What can I expect ?



Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected.

### Temporary Impacts

- > Changed traffic conditions including road closures, detours and reduced speed limits.
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > Temporary loss of street parking.
- > Temporary footpath closures.
- > Material storage and site office in designated nearby parks.

### What we are doing

- > Traffic controllers will be on duty during working hours.
- > Electronic signs will communicate traffic changes to road users.
- > Affected properties will be notified in advance of any disruption to access.

## Delivering a better stormwater network



Upgrading stormwater infrastructure is complex and involves excavation to install larger pipes, as well as relocating underground and overhead utilities such as power, gas and telecommunications.

To minimise impacts, works will be completed in stages, one section at a time. While temporary road closures cause inconvenience, the upgrades will improve long-term protection for people and property during heavy rainfall.
