What is happening?

We wanted to share a quick update on how things are progressing with the Water and Wastewater Main Relocation Project along Third Avenue, Second Avenue and Fourth Avenue in Marsden.

Survey, fire ant treatment and fauna forks completed

The survey works marking the property boundaries is now complete.

Fire ant treatment and fauna surveys have also been completed across the affected areas. These steps help to make sure the project continues safely and reliably.

Thank you to all residents for your cooperation and support. Your help in providing access has made it much easier for our crews to keep the project moving.

Updated timing for fencing & vegetation clearing

Progress is going well, however, temporary fencing installation and vegetation clearing is now planned for late March 2026, pending permits and approvals.

Permit to Enter (PTE) Forms

You should have received a **Permit to Enter (PTE)** form in your letterbox. Please complete the form and return it so our team can safely access your property for temporary fencing, vegetation clearing, and any required fence removal or installation.

What's coming up

Laydown area: Preparation works will begin in mid-to-late March 2026 and continue for approximately 4–6 weeks.

Vegetation clearing: Works will commence in late March 2026 and continue through to late May 2026.

Fencing works: Temporary fencing installation and fence relocation activities will take place across April and May 2026.

Underground drilling: Drilling works will begin in mid-to-late April 2026 and are expected to be completed by late June 2026.

Construction, traffic and safety

As work continues in the area, you may notice:

- Noise and dust at certain times
- Construction vehicles moving through local streets
- Temporary traffic changes, including reduced speeds, lane closures or short delays

- Traffic controllers and signage guiding motorists and pedestrians

- Follow all signage and any instructions from site staff
