International designer and environmental advocate

Jamie Durie OAM is an internationally acclaimed designer, author and television presenter with over 20 years experience across landscape, interior and furniture design.

Founder of the multi-disciplinary studio *Durie Design*, he has received more than 38 international awards, including a gold medal at the *RHS Chelsea Flower Show*.

Jamie has hosted over 56 prime-time television programs worldwide, most recently *Growing Home with Jamie Durie*, which aired on Channel 7, documenting the creation of his sustainable, off-grid dream home on Sydney's Northern Beaches.

He is also the author of 12 best-selling design books and a passionate environmental advocate, awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia for services to design and the environment.

After many years of study in Australia and overseas, Dr Jones graduated from various universities with so many degrees that she has more letters after her name than in it.

A self-confessed nature nerd, she has presented on *Catalyst* as well as hosted ABC TV documentaries such as *The Secret Life of Our Urban Birds*, *Southern Ocean Live* and *Meet the Penguins*. She can be heard across Australia showcasing the best of nature, adventure and scientific research on her weekly program, *Off Track* and is a regular guest on ABC Radio around the country.

Growing up in country Victoria, she has broadcast across a wide number of regional radio stations and has a special affinity with those who have a connection to land and nature.

Dr Jones brings warmth and curiosity to every MC role. A genuine communicator, her unique mix of gentle authority and empathy leads people to discover intrigue, even in the mundane.

Eco Mini Talks Stage, 10:15 am – 10:45 am

Hear from Spencer Hitchen, a 15-year-old dynamo conservationist, environmental educator and award-winning nature photographer on a mission to safeguard wildlife, wild places and birds from the brink of extinction.

He will talk about how his journey began with the inception of *Save Sunrise Glossies*, dedicated to protecting the local Wallum Ecosystem and his work to protect habitats and ecosystems for threatened species and birdlife.

At the age of 10 he started a global petition to protect his local ecosystem, going on to gather an impressive almost 86,000 signatures. Now eight years into his ecological crusade, Spencer has inspired millions across our planet. Spencer will share why it is so important we all *Stand UP 4 Nature* and have hope for the future.

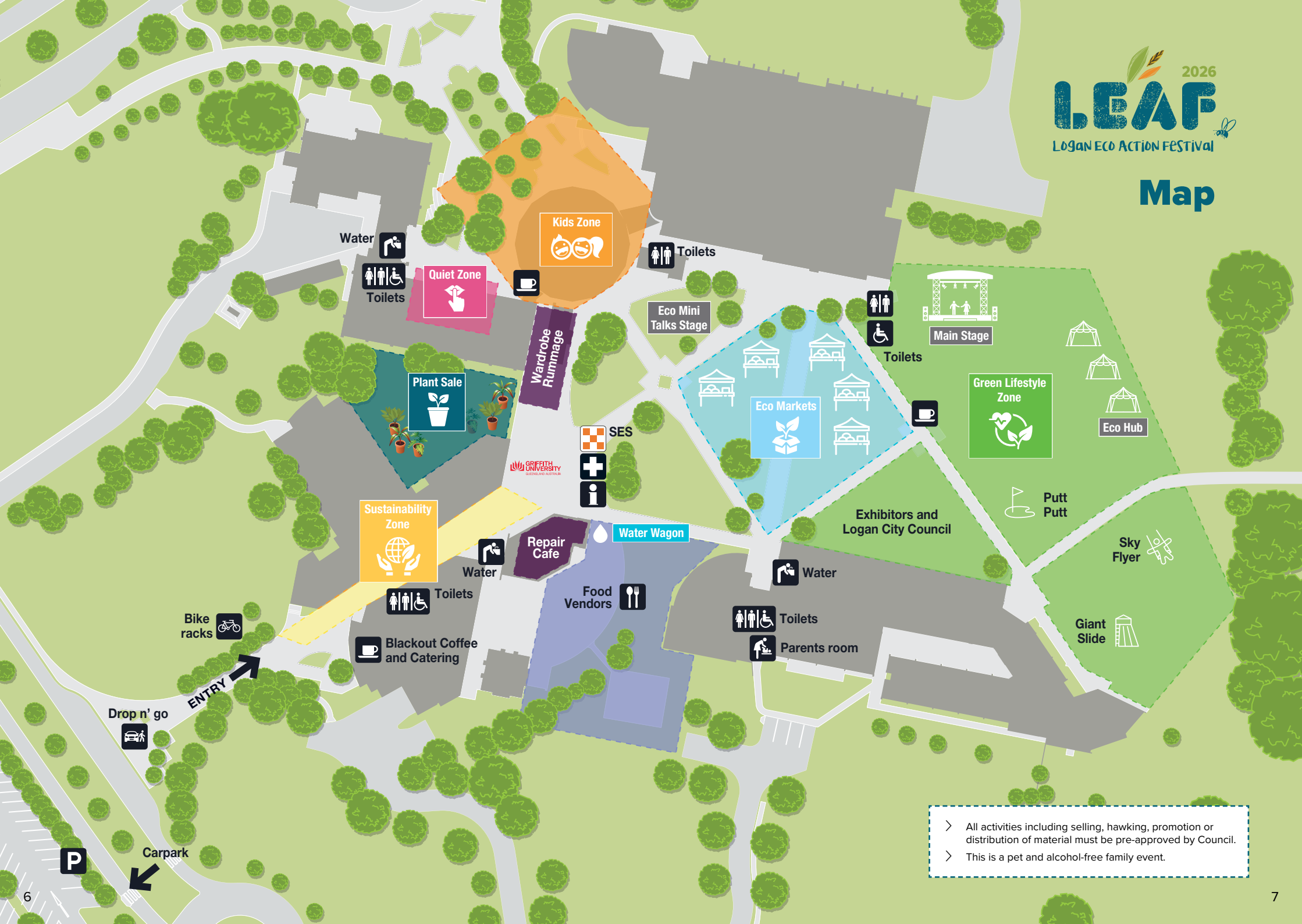
