What is happening ?

The intersection of Homestead Drive, Teviot Road and Glynton Road will be realigned to connect the new Teviot Road Extension.

The upgrade provides:

- > traffic signals for safer movement
- > additional turning, through and slip lanes to maintain traffic flow and improve connectivity
- > shared paths and bike lanes to support active transport
- > improved road drainage
- > road resurfacing and driveway reconstructions
- > connection with Teviot Road to the south to cater for future population growth.

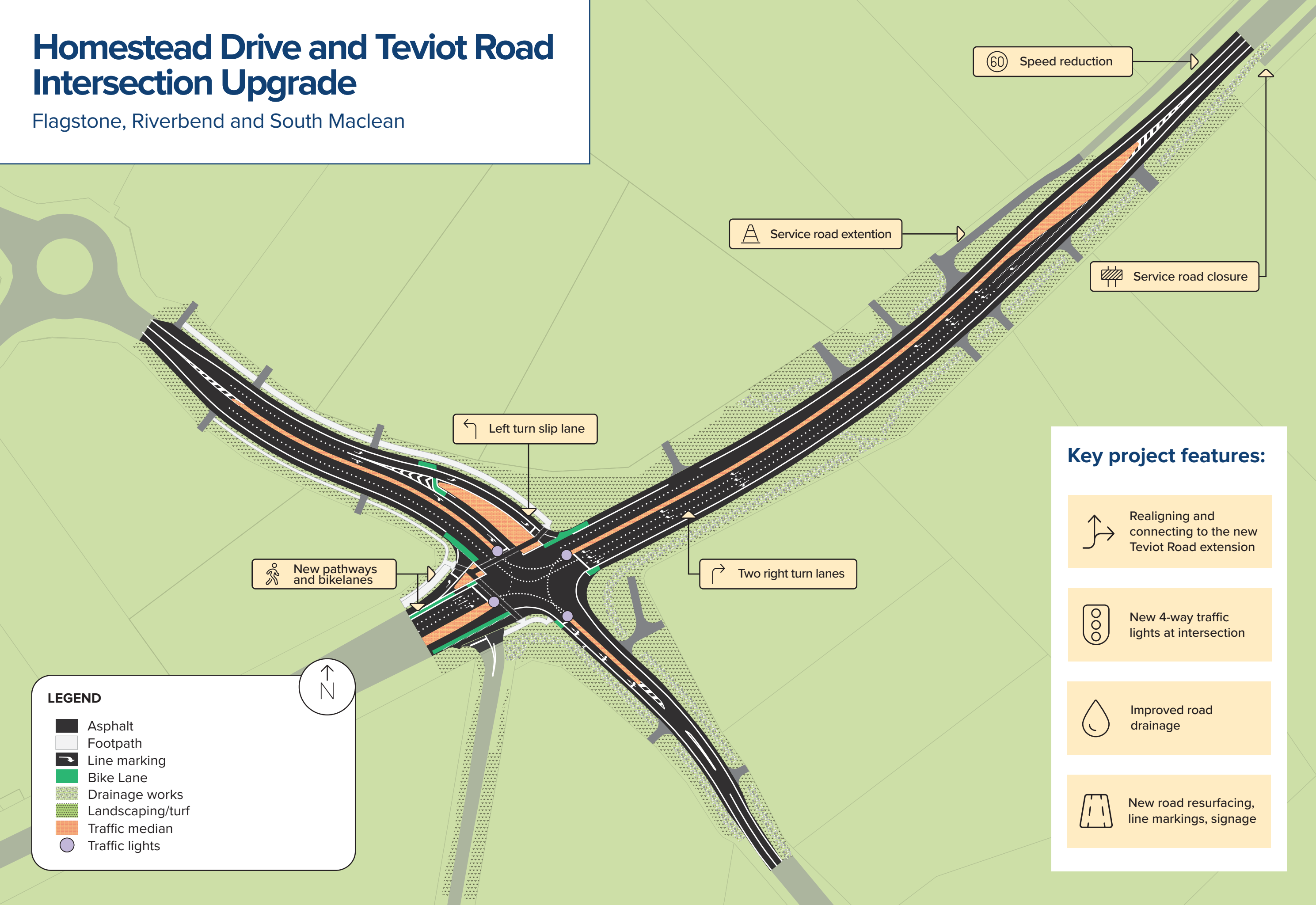
When is it happening ?

Main works will start late 2026. Works are expected to finish late 2027, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Activities will generally occur from Monday to Friday, 6 am to 6 pm. Nearby residents will be notified before works start and if we need to work outside normal hours.

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What can I expect ?



We appreciate your patience while we build a better road network.

Road users are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

Temporary Impacts

- > Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, and potential for road or lane closures and detours
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > Restricted driveway access within the work zone
- > Potential night works, if needed. Notice will be provided

What we are doing

- > Traffic controllers will be available for detours and lane closures during working hours
- > Directly impacted properties will be notified in advance of any changes to parking and driveway access, or temporary water, sewer or power interruptions

Finishing works Late 2027		Line marking, landscaping, signage and switching on of the new traffic signals. Completion of construction.
